Aarey metro car shed will meet Nanar refinery's fate: Uddhav

Mumbai: A day after Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis batted for a metro rail car shed in the metropolis' Aarey area, principal ally Shiv Sena's chief Uddhav Thackeray has warned the plan could end up like the aborted Nanar refinery in the Konkan region. Uddhav's assertion has the potential to further widen the chasm between the two saffron parties which are hassling over the number of seats to contest the Assembly elections, due next month. The car shed plan for Metro 3 (Colaba-Bandra-Seepz) line is in the midst of an acrimonious debate as the work will see the felling of over 2,600 trees in the Aarey area, considered among the city's prime green lungs. Responding to a question on the car shed, Thackeray said, "It will meet the fate of the oil refinery." Incidentally, son and Yuva Sena Thackeray has been in opposition to the plan. A proposed refinery in Nanar Ratnagiri district scrapped after the stiff resistance. In March the State Government notification issued to acquire 5,932 land across 14 Ratnagiri district talukas in Sindhudurg the refinery. On Sunday, the Supreme Court ruled that the Aarey project not come under forest diversification.

JD(S) will contest alone, says Deve Gowda

Bengaluru: Days after indicating that his party was still open for continuing its alliance with the Congress, JD(S) patriarch HD Deve Gowda on Monday spoke about going it alone, as he predicted mid-term polls in Karnataka. "There are chances of mid-term polls in the State. If they come, let's contest independently without going for an alliance with anyone," Gowda was quoted as saying in a statement by his office. "Will not still commit that mistake. Let's face all the elections independently," he said. After engaging in a blame game over the collapse of their coalition Government, Gowda on Thursday indicated his party was still open for continuing its alliance with the Congress. He had hinted that he was open for an alliance with the Congress in 17 Assembly constituencies, where bypolls have been necessitated following the disqualification of rebel MLAs, but said it all depended on the decision of the national party's interim president Sonia Gandhi. Gowda and Congress are strongman in the State. Siddaramaiah has blamed each other for the lapse of the HD Deve Gowda led coalition Government after it was rocked by the Congress. Both Congress leaders have also been in opposition over the coalition after the Karnataka Government. Congress leader and State party chief Deve Gowda and Siddaramaiah in the Karnataka Congress legislature have maintained the alliance with the Congress. However, several Congress leaders, speaking of anonymity, had said that the entire rationale of the party were happy partnership with the Congress. Amid speculation, several JD(S) legislators party, the former President said he was not worried and knows how to handle the party. Gowda has party workers to take the message of the 'good will' HDK as Chief Minister in the previous coalition Government to every household. "Those who..."
